Teachers participating in the Alaska Tsunami Education Program can earn up to 3 Continuing Education Credits from UAF under the guidance of Instructor Neal Brown. Course requirements are listed below.

To achieve 1 credit (16 hours of coursework), course participants must:

- Maintain monthly correspondence with Alaska Tsunami Education Program personnel.

- Complete Community Mapping Project

AND one of the following:

- Attend the Introductory Workshop in Anchorage, Chignik Bay, or Kodiak, Alaska. Contribute to discussions and pose questions during the workshop.
OR
- Complete at least two GIT lessons (plus feedback) if unable to attend

To achieve 2 credits, course participants must complete 1 credit requirements and:

- Guide program (GIT and Classroom) lessons and field-test new curriculum in the classroom for one hour per week.
- Submit lesson reviews of ATEP lessons taught in the classroom. Include strengths and weaknesses, and suggestions for improvement. Feedback can be sent in with worksheets or via e-mail.

To achieve 3 credits, course participants must complete 2 credit requirements and:

- Watch Scientist / Elder Mentor Lectures via DVD (in years 1-3 supply tubs) or Web site.
- Submit Lecture Review Forms following each of the Scientist / Elder Mentor Lectures.
- Attend Inquiry or Field-Test Workshop in Kodiak (date to be determined).
 - OR Complete at least two GIT lessons (plus feedback) if unable to attend
